

July 23 Praise Team - 1 pm-3 pm Choir - 3 pm-5 pm July 24 Choir - 10:30 pm or immediately following service


We will be ministering Friday and Saturday.


The rules for the game are as follows:

- 5. The team with the high team score total after 3 games will be declared the winner.
- 6. In the event of a tie the number of strikes for the 3 games will be used as a tie breaker.
- 7. In the event the strikes tie as well then we will use spares total.
- 8. Only bowlers who have bowled all 3 games can compete for top bowler.
- 9. Player with the highest average will be declared the winner.
