Homework Review

Nehemiah Chapter 1 & 2

Identify the need and incorporate spiritual disciplines/practices

- In preparation for any significant undertaking, our first step can be to follow the example of Nehemiah, who "fasted and prayed before the God of heaven" (1:4)
- When God puts a desire on your heart, continue to operate in your disciplines(prayer, fasting, quiet time with the Lord).

Nehemiah Chapter 1 & 2

Define a clear, concrete objective & set a time for completion

- When setting our own goals, we can follow Nehemiah and "set a time." (2:4)
- Give yourself benchmarks on when you would like to see some progress.
 Ministry is <u>not</u> a race, it's a marathon.

Nehemiah Chapter 1 & 2

Plan, Pray and Prepare

- Like Nehemiah, we ought to be careful to know what is required to accomplish our goal before asking others to join our project.
- A wise leader knows when to plan, when to speak, and when to work.
- People are more prone to join with you if you have a well detailed plan laid out for them.
